FL INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY CARRABELLE TO APALACHICOLA BAY Bridge Construction and Demolition UPDATE	On or about February 16, 2004, the replacement bridge over the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway, Mile 361.4 east of Harvey Lock, on State Road 300 at St. George Island, Franklin County, Florida, will be open to traffic. At that time, demolition of the two SR 300 Bridges will begin. The contractor will begin removing the bridges by mechanical means at the causeway area of the roadway. The island will be cleared and maintained as a bird sanctuary. A Corps of Engineers permit allows for 3300 of bridge to remain from the mainland and from the island. On or about March 1, 2004, the contractor will begin removal of the structural steel across the navigation channel by mechanical means. Mariners may experience delays of up to 4 hours during the lifts, but the contractor will clear the channel as soon as practicable. Removal of the structural steel should take approximately 1 week. On or about April 29, 2004, the contractor will demolish the 4 piers closest to the navigation channel by means of explosives. The channel will be closed during the demolition and mariners will be updated prior to the blasting. The auxiliary channel will be clear in a similar fashion during the months of April and May. The contractor expects to complete the removal of the bridges by June 30, 2004.
